



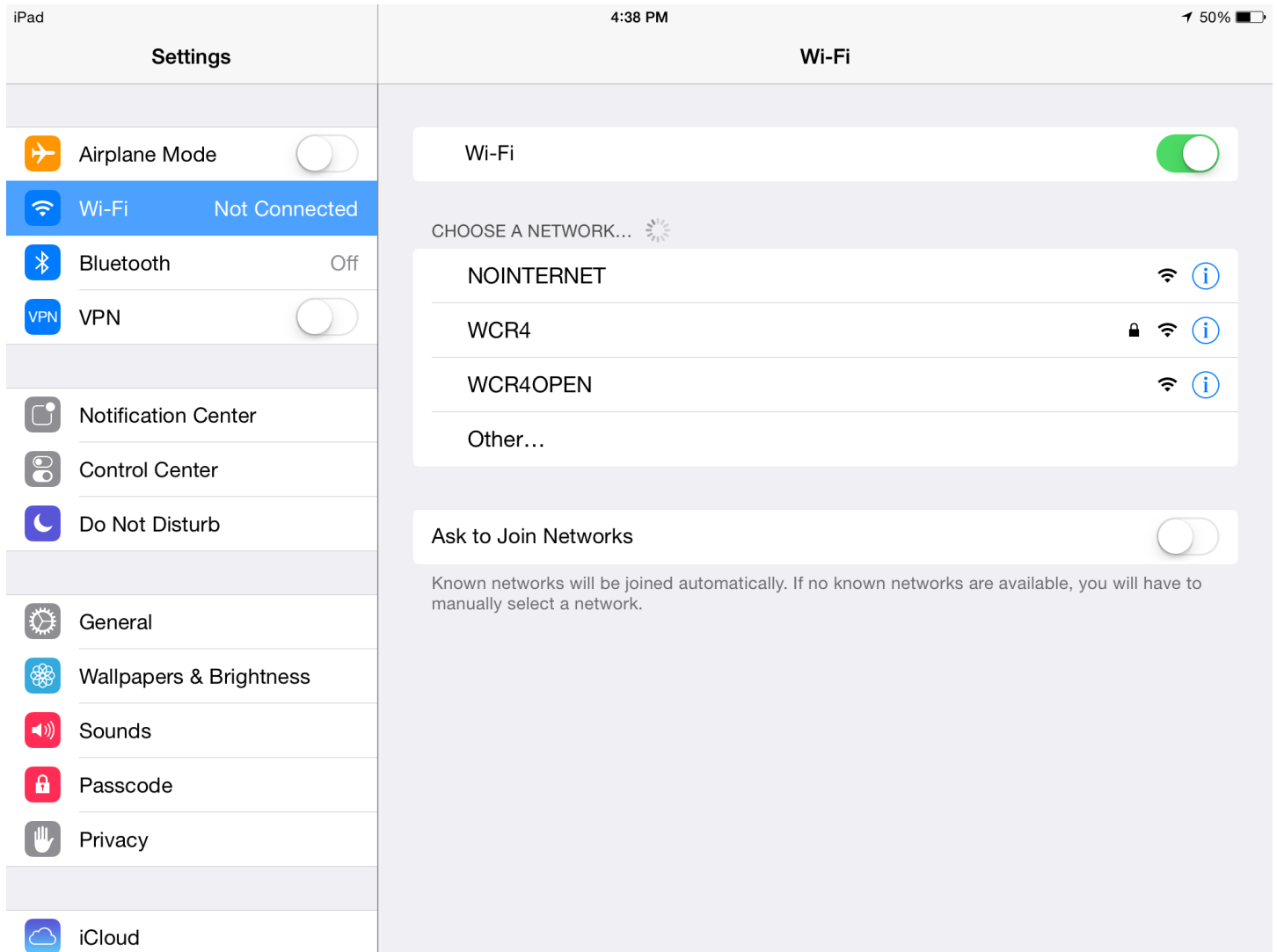
HowTo: Connect to WCR4OPEN

West County R-IV has implemented a new wireless infrastructure thus the process to connect to the District's open wireless network has changed as well. This tutorial will help you successfully connect your personal device to the open network.

*screenshots included in this tutorial are from an Apple iPad but the process should be similar across most devices

Step 1 - Connect to WCR4OPEN

-Open your wifi settings and connect...

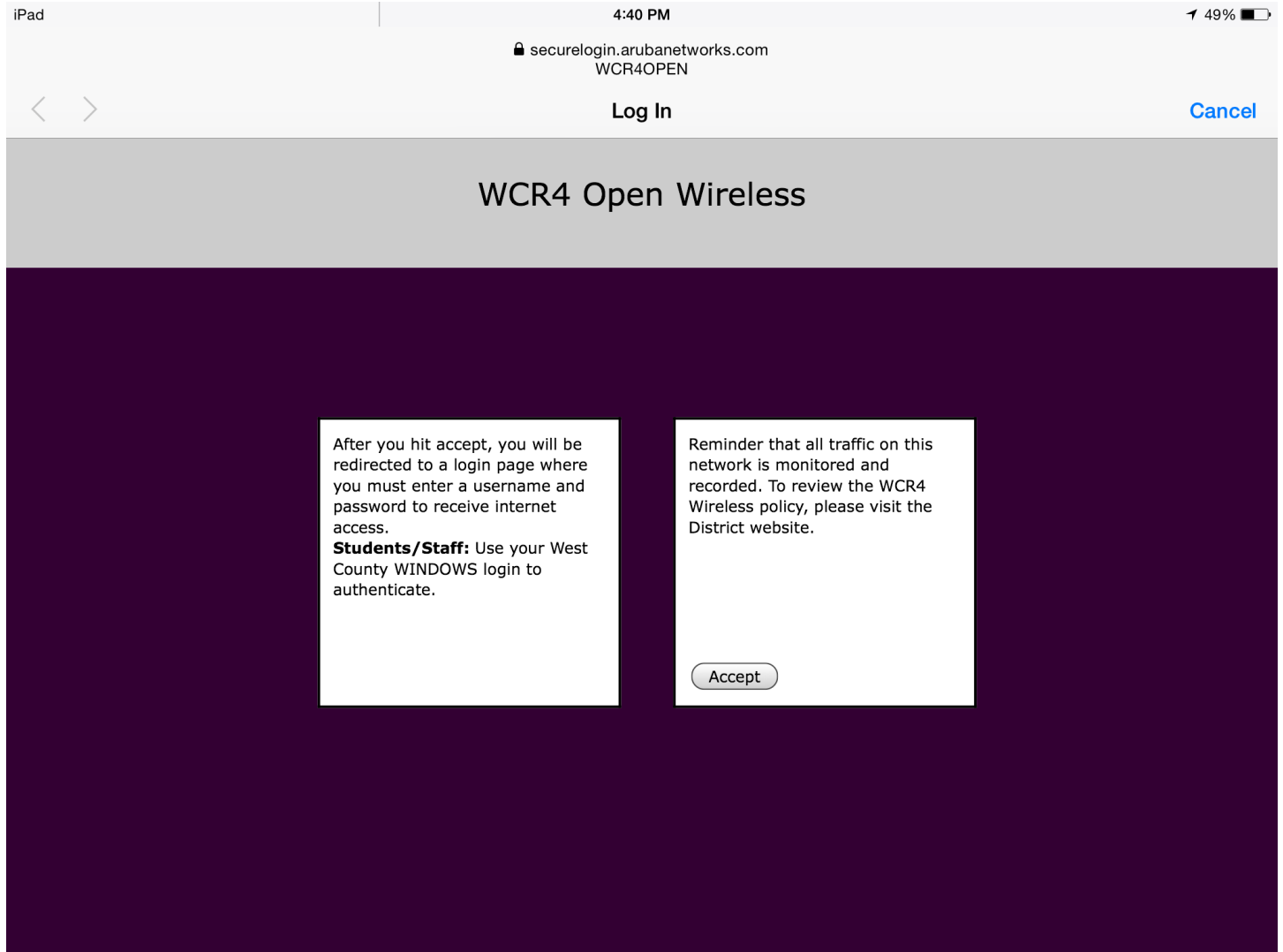

Step 2 – Acceptance Page

-After connecting, the Acceptance Page should appear (this page can take a few seconds to pop-up)

Read the instructions on the Acceptance Page and tap Accept...

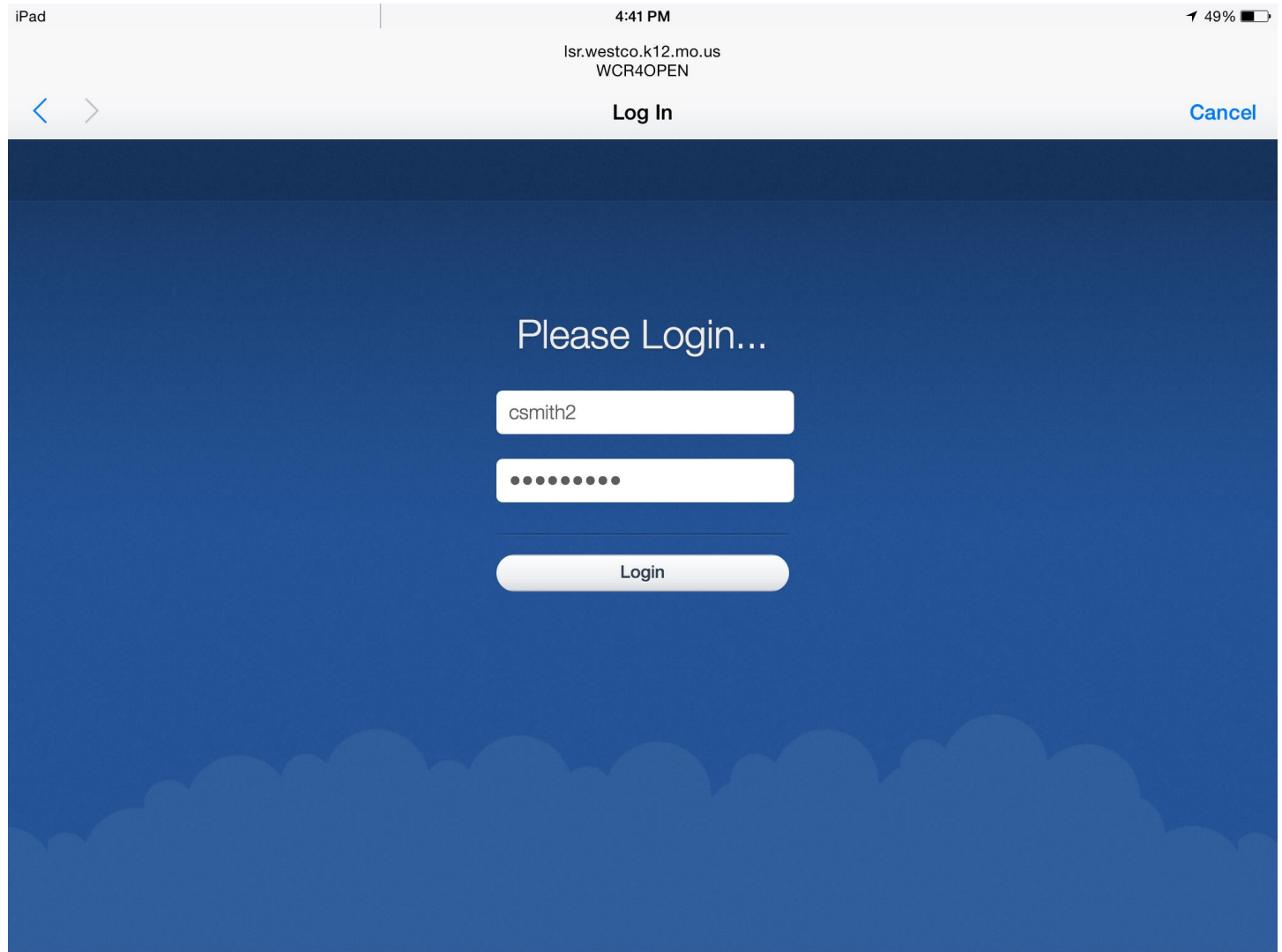

Step 3 – Authentication Page

After hitting Accept, you should be redirected to the Authentication Page where you'll enter your West County **WINDOWS** username & password to login. This page can take a few seconds to pop-up!

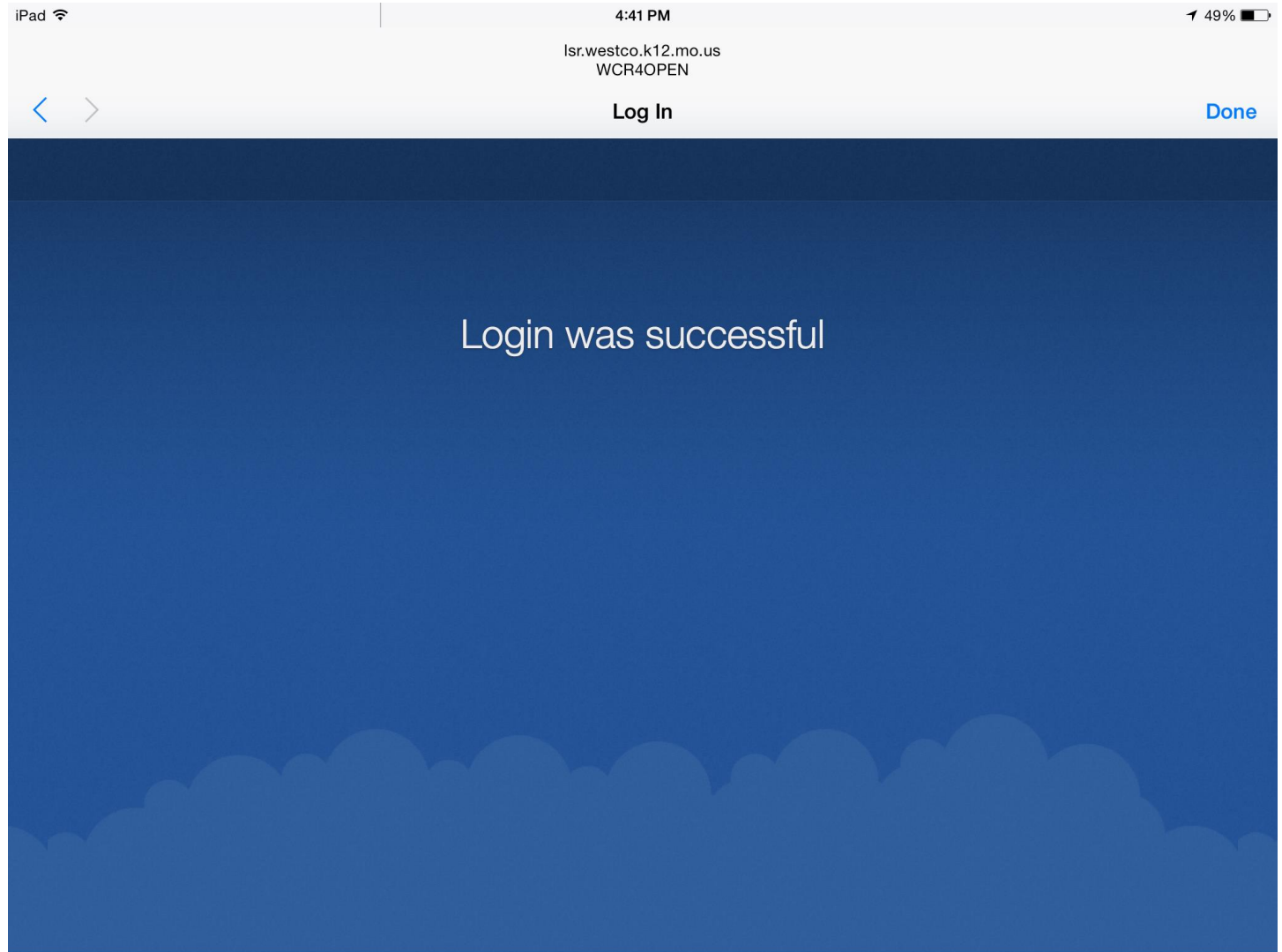


Continue to Page 4 →

Step 4 – Success!

After entering your login correctly, you should see a Login was successful message...



Final Notes:

- FOR APPLE DEVICES- On the Success Page, you need to wait until you see the word “Done” in the top right hand corner (see screenshot above).
- The authentication period lasts for 24 hours so basically everyone will need to authenticate their device once a day. (This whole process only takes a few seconds once you get the procedure down).
- The process outlined in this tutorial might be different on some Windows based devices (laptop, surface, etc). If you have trouble connecting this type of device, please contact the Technology Department.
- Middle School does NOT allow student to use cell phones.
